Workshop participants will learn fundamental skills for pouring cast iron from creating a sand mold to the pour itself. Everyone will go home with a creation of their own. All tools and materials will be provided; however participants should bring leather gloves, safety glasses, a respirator, appropriate clothing and wear close-toed shoes.

2009 Dates:

Mold Making*: July 3-July 12 (experienced iron mongers can start on June 27)

Iron Pour: July 11

Clean up: July 12

*Mold making will occur over a several day period. Participants will need to schedule time accordingly over the week to complete their mold.

Participants: Limited to 15 people, the group comprises of professional and amateur artists looking to further develop a skill or to branch out into a new medium.

Instructor Bio: Elijah Sproles is a sculptor living in New Orleans. He received his MFA in sculpture from the University of Minnesota. He has led numerous iron pouring and bronze casting workshops in America and in Europe.

Costs:

\$160 workshop fee (a non-refundable deposit of \$80 is due by May 15)

+ Materials fee (\$45/bag of sand & chemicals – with a one bag minimum; \$5/lb. of iron – with a ten pound minimum)

Fees will be due at the end of the workshop.
